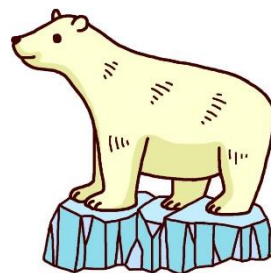

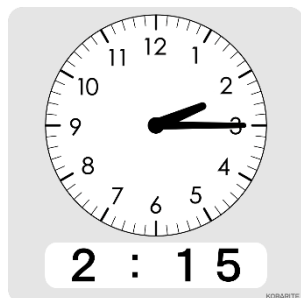

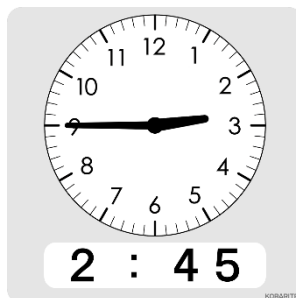

[5] 次の英文を読み、あとの問いに答えなさい。

She was born on May 4, 1929, in *Brussels, Belgium. ①She was a gifted performer known for her beauty, elegance and grace. She was the star of *Breakfast at Tiffany's* and remains one of Hollywood's greatest actresses and one of the world's most successful actresses. Can you guess who she is? Yes, her name is *Audrey Hepburn.

Hepburn spent part of her youth in England. During much of World War II, she studied in the Netherlands. After *the Nazis attacked the country, Hepburn and her mother tried to survive. She helped *the resistance movement by delivering messages.

After the war, Hepburn continued to be interested in dance. She studied ballet in Amsterdam and later in London. In 1948, Hepburn made her stage debut as a chorus girl in the musical *High Button Shoes* in London. At the age of 22, Hepburn went to New York and a few years later, she played the main role in a Hollywood film. She is one of the few actresses to win an Emmy, a Tony, a Grammy and an Academy Award.

But in the late 1980's, ②Audrey's film career came to a close. Then she began a new job: Special Ambassador for the United Nations Children's Fund. She kept working for five years until she died. ③UNICEF started in 1946 and is the largest *organization to work for children. It works with governments, local communities and non-governmental organizations. UNICEF gives emergency relief, and makes development programs in areas, for example, basic health care, nutrition, education, children's rights, HIV/AIDS prevention, and gender equality.

Audrey Hepburn's love for children made her decision to become the Special Ambassador for UNICEF an easy one. She said, "When I was little, I sometimes tried to pick up babies out of their *buggies at the market. My mother used to be very surprised at that." She also said, "④I want to not only receive love, but also give it. There is a moral *obligation that those who have should give to those who don't."

As the Special Ambassador, she went to a small village in Mexico in February 1989. She helped sick children and taught their mothers how to care for them.

She died on January 20, 1993 at her house in Switzerland. Until then, she traveled the world and tried to help children in need.
